Dear Parent/Carers,

We are noticing an increasing amount of pupils entering school without the approved school uniform and this letter is a reminder to you of what we expect pupils to wear each day.

At Homefield CE Primary School, we believe that it is essential that children wear a school uniform. Our school uniform makes the children look smart and gives them a sense of belonging. We expect shirts to be tucked in and ties to be worn in the correct manner. As children prepare for higher education and, eventually employment, getting used to uniforms and appropriate dress codes is essential.

Our uniform is as follows:

During the School Day

White shirt/blouse (long or short sleeved)

School tie (elasticated or tied)

Plain navy sweatshirt/jumper or cardigan with/without the school logo (not royal blue)

Black shoes (no trainers, Ugg boots, sports shoes or heels)

Black/grey trousers or grey/navy skirt (trousers for boys may be long or short depending on the weather)

Navy-checked summer dresses may be worn in hot weather

Skirts and dresses must be no higher than knee-length. There are to be no hoodies or branded tracksuit tops worn as alternatives to school jumpers/cardigans.

P.E.

Inside

Sky Blue polo shirt (no football shirts)

Navy shorts

Suitable footwear for outdoor sports

Outside

Sky Blue polo shirt (no football shirts)

Plain tracksuit/jogging bottoms

Plain sports jumper/jacket (No large logos/brands)

Children will be expected to wear the above kit for all PE lessons and school sports' event.

Jewellery

Children should not wear jewellery for school, because it can become a safety risk, especially whilst zooming about on the playground. However, if earrings are to be worn, we ask that they are single plain studs and that children are able to remove them themselves if needed. All jewellery will need to be removed, or taped up, for PE lessons. **No rings or necklaces are to be worn at any time.**



Hair styles, Make-up and Accessories

We ask that children come to school with a 'sensible' hairstyle that is suitable for school. We would consider changes in colour, shaved patterns and extreme styles to be unsuitable. These would be fine as holiday styles, but are not permitted during term time.

No make-up of any description is to be worn, such as nail varnish, eye make-up or lipstick etc.

If accessories are needed for longer hair styles (hair bands, bobbles etc) we ask that these are of a 'sensible' and 'suitable' style. We would consider fluorescent colours and oversize accessories to be unacceptable.

Nursery

We like our nursery children to look just as smart as all of the other classes. Nursery children need to wear a white/navy Ark polo shirt and a black/grey skirt/trousers. Navy Ark jumpers/cardigans should also be worn in colder weather.

We understand that from time to time clothing needs to be replaced through general wear and tear and as a result children may need to come to school in alternative items temporarily, until replacement items have been purchased soon after. Normally, we allow a week for replacement items to be obtained. Please inform staff that this is the case. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, the school may be able to offer support with uniform.

Pupils whose appearance continues to fall short of school uniform expectations will have the matter raised with their parents.

We appreciate your support with this matter.
