MUSIC LESSONS

We also offer keyboard, flute, ukulele and guitar lessons for certain year groups. Some of these lessons need to be paid for but they are most definitely worth it.

Flute, ukulele and recorder lessons are with Mrs. Loveland.

Flute will be on a Friday PM for Years 4, 5 and 6 (children already involved in lessons may continue without the need to re-sign). These lessons will need to be paid for.

Recorder will be held during a Monday lunchtimes from 12:30PM for any children between Years 1-6. Ukulele will be held during a Thursday lunchtimes from 12:30PM for any children between Years 1-6. (Maximum 8 spaces)

Keyboard lessons are with Mrs. Harrison and need to be paid for. These take place on Thursday afternoons.

Guitar lessons are continuing, if you are interested. Our teacher, Mr. Barnes, is fabulous and you must pay for guitar lessons on our ParentMail site in the same way you would for other lessons.

Drumming lessons are also continuing with Mr. Wooden. It was extremely popular last term and we hope this continues. Again, payments for lessons must be made on our ParentMail site.

BEHAVIOUR

Any payments for clubs must be made through our ParentMail system. If you are experiencing problems with this, please come into speak to our School Office.

CLUB SIGN UP INSTRUCTIONS

From 8:30am on Friday 20th April parents can sign up for the clubs their children wish to participate in. Older children can sign up themselves (with permission), if they are without parents.

All staff leading the clubs will be on the playground at that time to register names of all those interested. If the club booklet states to sign directly with the teacher leading the club, please do so. You will not be able to sign up for those clubs at the Office. Please form an orderly queue at that member of staff, so that they can take down names.

For all other clubs, as stated, please sign up at the School Office. If a queue forms, please queue around the designated footpath behind the white railings for your own safety and not into the car park.

For all limited space clubs, children will only be able to sign up for TWO of them in the interests of fairness.

Remember for some clubs, places are limited, so please do not be disappointed if your child does not obtain a place. Maintain a growth mindset, as there will be other opportunities in the future or simply try and join something else where there is a space. Some clubs with limited spaces may, if popular, rotate each half-term to allow those who missed out the first time around to attend. We look forward to seeing the level of interest in the clubs we have on offer.
