

Termly Curriculum Overview

English Spring 1: Writing to Persuade

Poster: Posters to persuade people to buy a chocolate bar we invented.

Adverts: Radio adverts to persuade people to buy a product that we have invented.

English Spring 2: Writing to Entertain

Legends and Quests: Robin Hood

Poetry: If I had wings by Pie Corbett.

Expressive Arts

Art We will be creating 3D box frames. Focusing on architect and architecture.

Music Developing skills to enable us to create music for specific reasons. Learning about the style of Reggae.

History: Great Yarmouth Fishing Industry

We will be learning about the history of the fishing industry in Great Yarmouth. We will learn about why it is important and how things have changed over time.

R.E.: Christianity focus

How do Christians talk about God?

We will discuss and look at how people who are Christian may talk about God in different ways.

Science: Physical Processes

Plants: Names of parts of plants and their functions. The lifecycle of a plant and how water travels around a plant.

Animals including humans: The different types and right types of nutrition. The functions of skeletons and muscles.

Working scientifically: Making comparisons, identifying and classifying, making observations over time, making observations.

Term: Spring

Computing

Programming unit. We will be focusing on creating, following and debugging algorithms.

We will be using Scratch to make different shapes and the Bee-Bot iPad app or Fake-Bots to help us learning about directional language.

Geography

We will be learning about the geography of the United Kingdom. Naming and locating UK counties or cities and describing what they are like. We will use maps and atlases to identify key features.

Maths

Multiplication and Division: Revisiting multiplying and dividing by 3, 4 and 8. Multiply and divide a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number.

Measure: We will spend a block of time focusing on money and another block focusing on length and perimeter.

Fractions: We will start our fraction unit revisiting what we already know and finding fractions of amounts.

MFL: German

Counting to 12, How old we are, colours and where we live.

PSHE/British Values

Living in the wider world: We will spend the first half term learning about British Values. We will learn about the diversity of our country, liberty, democracy and rules & laws.

The second half term we will be learning about how we can be responsible citizens.
