- I can talk to adults about what I like and ask questions to find out more.
- I can tell you what I like best and what I'm good at.
- I am learning to tell my friends why I feel upset or cross.

Literacy

- I can tell you words that rhyme with a word like 'cat'.
- I can hear and tell you the first sound in a word when you say it.
- I try to make up my own stories based on my favourite books, during play.

Physical Development

- I can manage my own shoes and socks when changing for PE
- I can use scissors effectively and safely as well as other one handed tools such as hammers.
- I can write some letters with a pen or pencil that you can recognise.

Mathematics

- I can tell you which group of objects has 'more' or 'less/fewer'.
- I can guess how many things I see in a group, then count them to see how close my guess was.
- I can use some words such as 'pounds or pence' when playing shops.

Communication & Language

- I can make up my own stories and I would love it if you wrote them down.
- I can follow instructions to do two or more things.
- I can listen to friends or adults who are talking whilst I am doing something else.

Understanding The World

- I can talk about how things change like seeds growing into plants or vegetables.
- I understand that my friends and their families may do things differently to me, such as what they eat or what they celebrate.
- I am interested in how things work such as remote control toys.
