Personal, Social & Emotional Development

I can form a friendship with a peer in my class.

I will listen and follow simple instructions and show that I can follow the rules and boundaries.

I will use my "All About Me" book to talk about my special people and recent events to the adults and children of Reception so that they get to know me.

I will think of ideas to add to others' chats in my new class.

Expressive Arts and Design

I can use a mirror to help me paint a picture of myself.

I can use the right colours to paint a picture of "Me!"

I will learn to explore the different sounds that musical instruments can make.

I will be imaginative using things I have seen or done to make up imaginative play scenarios in small world or roleplay with my friends.

Literacy

I will know that print carries meaning and can identify some familiar logos outside school.

I will listen to and enjoy a range of stories, poems and "finding-out" books.

I will begin learning to write my name, forming letters correctly and in the correct order working from left to right.

I will mark make labels for my models and in imaginative play.

Mathematics

I will be able to say numbers in order to ten and be able to count up to ten objects correctly.

I will be able to say which group has 'more' and/ or 'less' objects.

I will learn the Days of the Week song and talk about times of the day and the sequence of activities in our day.

Understanding of the World

I can talk about special times in my life with my class using "My All About Me" book to initiate chats.

I can ask questions about others' when sharing our special books.
