Maths

We will start off with Number place value involving counting forwards and backwards, as well as reading and writing numbers to 10. Finding one more and less than any number to 20 and representing numbers through pictures, objects and number lines. We will then move on to addition and subtraction involving number bonds to 10, + - = signs and one step addition and subtraction problem solving.



English

To start this half term we will be reading and retelling Traditional tales, followed by reading and writing stories with repetitive phases. We will be focusing on speaking and listening, sequencing stories, simple sentence writing including capital letters, full stops and exclamation marks.

Music
